Brookes Westshore's IB Diploma Programme offers students a rigorous academic experience while preparing them for life in top universities. The IB Diploma emphasizes rigorous college preparation across a two-year program, where students focus on six subject areas.

The IB Program also features a unique Extended Essay program, where students write a 4000-word research paper over the course of two years.

Beautiful Location

Brookes Westshore is located in beautiful Victoria, British Columbia, which is located on Vancouver Island. The Island is home to Pacific Rim National Park, featuring stunning beaches, rainforests, lakes and mountains. The natural landscape of the island allows students the opportunity for hands-on biology and environmental study.

Service as Action Program

Students in Grades 6-10 take part in Service as Action activities, where they volunteer to make a difference in their community. Through this, students work with a mentor to ensure they're developing Commitment and Leadership skills.

In grades 11 and 12, IB students are required to give back through the unique Creativity, Activity, Service (CAS) program. Here, students have a leadership role in giving back, which helps them develop key skills such as collaboration, problem solving and decision making.

Strong Arts Program

Brookes Westshore students are encouraged to explore their creativity through courses like Visual Arts, Drama and Studio Arts. In these classes, they work with a range of media, including painting, drawing, ceramics, printmaking, stop-motion video and much more.

Dedicated University Counseling

Starting in 9th grade, students begin focusing on the university admissions process, with weekly seminars taught by University Counselors and assessments of their skills and interests. Each student works closely with a University Counselor, who helps with all aspects of the university application process. Additionally, university visits are incorporated into the school year, where students can meet with university representatives from around the world.
