Middle school students at both campuses complete a rigorous schedule in all core disciplines, including three lab science classes (physics, chemistry and biology), foreign language and a course in logic. BASIS Independent students take a minimum of four AP courses during their high school career, and most students take more than nine.

In 2022, more than 40% of BIB students were offered seats in the top 25-ranked national and international universities. The majority of students (80%) received acceptances from national and globally-ranked schools in the top 50.
